Picnic: Newton reported that she had spoken to the Chamber of Commerce. The July 31 date did not have any major events. August 6 was already the Moose Lake Festival. Motion by P. Sanders, second by G. Heimbach to set the date for our picnic as July 31, 2010. Newton suggested that we set a timeline in January for the picnic next year.

Rescue boat: Discussion about the type of rescue boat that might be needed. Chief Mullet has a video tape of the inflatable boat that he is suggesting. G. Brueggen suggested that we practice snow rescue as soon as we have enough snow for the snowmobiles. He also suggested talking to the Town Board about leaving some snow on the roads that are a route to each of the lakes for ease of getting our snowmobile to the site.

Budget: P. Sanders suggested adding wireless headsets for the Engines. He also pointed out that he is taking a Wild Fire Course and we lack Fire shelter bags large enough for several of our members. Extra large shelter bags will be ordered.
